

- Boat registrations continue. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, <a href="www.svla.com">www.svla.com</a>. All paperwork can be submitted on-line at Just a reminder <a href="Admin@svla.com">Admin@svla.com</a>. Staff is available to take your calls. Once registration and payment are complete; Public Safety will set-up the safety inspection. Part of the safety inspection is to verify the length of your boat. Maximum length for pontoon boats is 24 feet and all other boats is 22 feet. Upon passing the inspection Public Safety will give you the stickers.
- As of August 20<sup>th,</sup> 533 powered vessels and 370 non-powered vessels have been registered for the 2020 year. There are 17 powered vessel stickers left for the year. There is a wait list for boat slips.
- Just a reminder: <u>Any changes, updates, additions to your property or exterior of your home must have Architectural Committee Approval.</u> To submit an Architecture Application, you must make an appointment. You can do this through the website or call the AO and ask for the Architectural Department. Fines will be issued for any projects without approval. All information to submit an Architectural Project application for approval can be found on the website or call the Association Office.
- Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association facebook page, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community.
- The association is verifying and/or updating members contact information. This is to include phone numbers and email addresses. In case of an emergency we want to be able to reach you be phone. Also, a lot of information is sent out my email. Email will get the info to you much faster than the Breeze newsletter which is once a month.
