

Spring Valley Lake Association Administrative Monthly Report Board of Director's Regular Meeting January 26, 2021

- Boat registrations for the 2021 are underway. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, www.svla.com. All paperwork can be submitted on-line at Admin@svla.com. Once the safety inspection and measuring of the vessel is complete the registration process and payment can be completed at the admin office or on-line. Please call Public Safety to set-up the safety inspection. Part of the safety inspection is to verify the length of your boat. Maximum length for pontoon boats is 24 feet and all other boats is 22 feet.
- All Tenants must renew their membership. Tenant membership is November 1st to October 31st. You must renew every year. Applications are available on the web-site and in the association office.
- Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address.

- Board of Directors Election Meeting will be April 24th. If you are a property owner and interested in running for the board you must submit your Intent to Run by February 12, 2021.
