- Help us keep your contact information up to date. If you have any changes, please contact the association. This includes phone numbers, emails, mailing address, emergency contacts.
- Vessel registrations for the 2022 Year began December 1, 2021. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, <u>www.svla.com</u>. All paperwork can be submitted on-line at <u>Admin@svla.com</u>. Safety inspections of the vessel is the first step to complete in the registration process. Call Public Safety to schedule the inspection. Once the inspection is complete the registration process is completed at the Association Office.
- As of Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> 365 powered vessels and 345 non-powered vessels have been registered.
- There is a wait list for boat slips. Members must have a vessel registered to rent a slip.
- Just a reminder: <u>Any changes, updates, additions to your property or exterior of your home must have</u> <u>Architectural Committee Approval.</u> To submit an Architecture Application, you must schedule an appointment. You can do this through the website or call the AO and ask for the Architectural Department. Fines will be issued for any projects without approval.
- Be sure to get a free pet tag for your pet. If your pet is found, we will call you based on the phone number on file when you register. This does not replace the county registration.
- Lost & Found items are kept in Public Safety. If you have lost something, check in with PSD. If you find something, you may drop it off at the Association office or PSD office.
