

Spring Valley Lake Association Administrative Monthly Report Board of Director's Regular Meeting June 28, 2022

- Always have your member ID with you on association property. Anyone over 12 years of age and older must have a card. Each property is issued four guest cards. On Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and at association events guests must be accompanied by a member. Members may also request 6 one day passed four times a year. For larger groups, members can schedule an event. This is for the beach park or event rooms. There are requirements. Contact the association office for details.
- Stay informed. Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association face-book page, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community. What is the best way to find out what is going on in the community? Check out the association's website at www.svla.com. - Help us keep your contact information up to date. If you have any changes, please contact the association. This includes phone numbers, emails, mailing address, emergency contacts.
- Vessel registrations for the 2022 Year began December 1, 2021. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, www.svla.com. All paperwork can be submitted on-line at Admin@svla.com. Safety inspections of the vessel is the first step to complete in the registration process. Call Public Safety to schedule the inspection. Once the inspection is complete the registration process is completed at the Association Office.
- As of Friday, June 24th 463 powered vessels and 416 non-powered vessels have been registered.
- There is a wait list for boat slips. Members must have a vessel registered to rent a slip.
- There is a wait list for horse stalls.
- Be sure to get a free pet tag for your pet. If your pet is found, we will call you based on the phone number on file when you register. This does not replace the county registration.
- Yard/Garage Sale permits are issued by Public Safety. Their office is located in the community center on Rolling Ridge Drive.
- Lost & Found items are kept in Public Safety. If you have lost something, check in with PSD. If you find something, you may drop it off at the Association office or PSD office.
