July 28, 2020

- Boat registrations continue. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, [www.svla.com](http://www.svla.com). All paperwork can be submitted on line at [registermyvessel@svla.com](mailto:registermyvessel@svla.com) or at [Admin@svla.com](mailto:Admin@svla.com). Staff is available to take your calls. Once registration and payment are complete; Public Safety will set-up the safety inspection. Upon passing the inspection Public Safety will give you the stickers.
- As of July 24<sup>th</sup>, 506 powered vessels and 358 non-powered vessels have been registered for the 2020 year. There are 44 powered vessel stickers left for the year. There is a wait list for boat slips.
- Assessments are due August 1<sup>st</sup>. Late fees will be added on August 16<sup>th</sup>. Payment must be received by August 15<sup>th</sup> to avoid late fees. Payments may be mailed, paid on-line, the info to pay on-line is on the statement, or you may drop your payment of at the association office. A drop box is located to the right of the entrance to the office.
- Owners of Rental Property are required to submit the proper license from San Bernardino County or Town of Apple Valley depending on the location of the rental(s).
- Just a reminder: Any changes, updates, additions to your property or exterior of your home must have Architectural Committee Approval. To submit an Architecture Application, you must make an appointment. You can do this through the website or call the AO and ask for the Architectural Department. Fines will be issued for any projects without approval. All information to submit an Architectural Project application for approval can be found on the website or call the Association Office.
- Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association facebook page, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community.
