- Boat registrations continue. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, www.svla.com. All paperwork can be submitted on line at registermyvessel@svla.com or at Admin@svla.com. Staff is available to take your calls. Once registration and payment are complete; Public Safety will set-up the safety inspection. Upon passing the inspection Public Safety will give you the stickers.
- As of April 23rd, 210 powered vessels and 177 non-powered vessels have been registered for the 2020 year. Boat slips are going quick. If you wish to rent a boat slip for the summer don't wait.
- Assessments are due May 1st. Instructions are the courtesy statement of where to mail your payment to or for on-line payments. You may also drop your payment of at the association office. Just slide the envelope through the double doors.
- Board of Director's Election Meeting was April 25, 2020. If quorum was met which is 25% of property owners submitting their ballot; welcome to the new Board. If quorum was not met, the Election meeting will reconvene on May 2, 2020, at 10:00 AM. Quorum is reduced to 15% for the May 2nd meeting.
- Owners of Rental Property are required to submit the proper license from San Bernardino County or Town of Apple Valley depending on the location of the rental(s).
- Just a reminder: <u>Any changes, updates, additions to your property or exterior of your home must have Architectural Committee Approval.</u> To submit an Architecture Application, you must make an appointment. You can do this through the website or call the AO and ask for the Architectural Department. Fines will be issued for any projects without approval. All information to submit an Architectural Project application for approval can be found on the website or call the Association Office.
- Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association facebook page, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community.
