April 26, 2022

- Board of Directors Election is April 30, 2022. Ballots were mailed the end of March. If you have not received your ballot or need a replacement you will need to call TIE and request one. Hopefully you have mailed in your ballot as the must be received at TIE's office by Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup>. Returning your ballot is very important as quorum must be met to have the meeting and count the ballots.
- Assessments are due May 1<sup>st</sup>. Late fees are assessed on the account on May 16<sup>th</sup> if payment is not made.
- Stay informed. Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association facebook page, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community. - Help us keep your contact information up to date. If you have any changes, please contact the association. This includes phone numbers, emails, mailing address, emergency contacts.
- Vessel registrations for the 2022 Year began December 1, 2021. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association website, [www.svla.com](http://www.svla.com). All paperwork can be submitted on-line at [Admin@svla.com](mailto:Admin@svla.com). Safety inspections of the vessel is the first step to complete in the registration process. Call Public Safety to schedule the inspection. Once the inspection is complete the registration process is completed at the Association Office.
- As of Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> 271 powered vessels and 253 non-powered vessels have been registered.
- Boat slips are filling up. Don't wait for summer. As of Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup> there is 1 slip available.
- Just a reminder: Any changes, updates, additions to your property or exterior of your home must have Architectural Committee Approval. To submit an Architecture Application, you must schedule an appointment. You can do this through the website or call the AO and ask for the Architectural Department. Fines will be issued for any projects without approval.
- Be sure to get a free pet tag for your pet. If your pet is found, we will call you based on the phone number on file when you register. This does not replace the county registration.
- Lost & Found items are kept in Public Safety. If you have lost something, check in with PSD. If you find something, you may drop it off at the Association office or PSD office.
- It has been a pleasure working with the Board. So much has been accomplished. This Board has worked so hard to get things done. You are all AWESOME!
