- Disclosure packets and statements were mailed to all property owners. The first quarter payment is due Tuesday, November 1, 2022. Payments may be made by check or money order in the association office. Payment may be mailed to the association or to Consortium. Payments may also be made online through Consortium. If it is your first time using the online payment process, you will need to call Consortium for a password.
- Be sure to update you bill pay through your bank so that the correct amount is paid. If you have EFT the correct amount will be pulled from your bank.
- Help us keep your contact information up to date. If you have any changes, please contact the association. This includes phone numbers, emails, mailing address, emergency contacts.
- Always have your member ID with you on association property. Anyone over 12 years of age and older must have a card. Each property is issued four guest cards. On Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and at association events guests must be accompanied by a member. Members may also request 6 one day passed four times a year. For larger groups, members can schedule an event. This is for the beach park or event rooms. There are requirements. Contact the association office for details. Guest cards have a blue banner at the bottom of the card. Member ID cards with picture has a green band at the bottom of the card.
- Stay informed. Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our website, the association face-book page, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community. What is the best way to find out what is going on in the community? Check out the association's website at www.svla.com. There is a lot of information available along with the governing documents under the tab titled "I want to" ... Also, check out our Facebook page, Spring Valley Lake Association. - Non-powered vessels are allowed on the lake at this time. All non-powered vessels shall enter the lake from the boat ramp at the association office. Use the call box at the ramp to call Public Safety to open the gate.
- There is a wait list for horse stalls. Call the office to put your name on the list if you are in need of a stall.
- Be sure to get a free pet tag for your pet. If your pet is found, we will call you based on the phone number on file when you register. This does not replace the county registration.
- Lost & Found items are kept in Public Safety. If you have lost something, check in with PSD. If you find something, you may drop it off at the Association office or PSD office.
