PACKAGE SERVICE

This holiday season, be mindful of your packages. Here are some helpful tips to follow:

- If you're expecting a delivery while you are away from home, try contacting the delivery company and request to pick it up from an authorized facility.
- Ask a friend, neighbor, or family member to pick up your package after delivery to your door.

If you still require assistance, you can contact the Public Safety department. An officer can attempt to conceal your package from the general view of the public. If this cannot be done, our Public Safety department can hold your package for up to 24 hours. A held package can only be picked up by the owner with valid I.D. that matches the name on the package.
