June 25, 2019

- Always have your Membership Card with you on Association property. Just a reminder that guests must be accompanied by the property owner on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays, Association events, and holidays. Do not give your tenant your guest card to use.
- 57 Tenants have been approved for membership with 10-15 more applications waiting for approval.
- Warm weather is coming. Don't wait to register your boat/vessel for the 2019 year. Requirements to register vessels are available on the association web-site or call the association office to verify the documents needed to register the boat/vessel. You will also need a safety inspection completed by Public Safety and a current Vessel Operator's Permit.
- 314 powered vessels and 242 non-powered vessels have registered. 84 slips are rented, so if you want a boat slip don't wait.
- Owners of Rental Property are required to submit the Crime-Free Addendum and the proper license from San Bernardino County or Town of Apple Valley depending on the location of the rental(s). A new Crime-Free Addendum is needed when you have new tenants. Citations have been issued to those not in compliance.
- Just a reminder: Any changes, updates, additions to your property or exterior of your home must have Architectural Committee Approval. Fines will be issued for any projects without approval. All the information to submit an Architectural Project application for approval can be found on the web-site or call the Association Office.
- Sign-up for e-blasts; contact the association office to sign-up or go to the web-site www.svla.com. All we need is your email address. A lot of information about the association can be found on our web-site, the association face-book page, Instagram, the Breeze and bulletin boards through-out the community.
- Volunteer on a committee and help your community! You must reapply to serve on a committee in May. Applications are available on-line and in the association office.
- Pet tags are issued at the Association Office and at Public Safety. The tags are free. Keep contact information up to date.
- School will be out soon so be extra cautious driving around.
