

A primary purpose of a homeowners' association is to maintain and enhance property values. One of the ways it does this is by offering and maintaining amenities. Homeowners' associations are able to provide desirable amenities that homeowners would not be able to afford individually. In Spring Valley Lake, association members have access to a beach and swimming area, a large boating lake, several (stocked) fishing areas, four parks, a community building and an equestrian center with a clubhouse, horse boarding and miles of horse-riding trails.

Homeowner associations also maintain property values by establishing and enforcing rules and regulations. Spring Valley Lake Association has Code Enforcement, Architectural, and Public Safety Departments that work to help maintain and enhance property values. Be sure to attend the Town Hall in September to discuss the proposed updated rules and regulations.

The Semi Annual Membership Budget Meeting is Saturday,

August 25, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. in the Community Center. The General Manager Alfred Logan, Board Treasurer Mark Sedam, Board Vice President John Smith and the Budget Review Committee are currently reviewing the financial statements from this fiscal year and prior fiscal years to create a budget for Fiscal Year 2018 - 2019. They are considering the various needs, requirements and expectations that the community has expressed throughout the year. They will present their proposed budget(s) at the Budget Meeting. Alfred Logan will share staff comments and recommendations. The Budget Review Committee members will offer their comments and recommendations. The Board will take a short break to give homeowners time to process the information. Homeowners will have the opportunity to ask questions and make comments about the information presented. After the Homeowners' Open Forum, the Board will discuss the recommendations and comments and determine the 2018-2019 Budget and annual assessment.

Please plan to attend the Budget Meeting on August 25th to learn about your homeowners' association's budget and to give your input.



## PROJECTS AROUND THE COMMUNITY

We are in the final stages of the Gazebo replacement project at the EQ and will be wrapping it up this month. It should be ready for our annual Hoedown in October.

The family festival and firework show were a great success. We added a required rule to boating that night and thank you to all for following these instructions. We had no issues meeting the safety requirements set forth that night. If you were able to enjoy the show from the beach we started the show with the American flag on display—the National Anthem timed with the firework start. Great day, great show, we hope you enjoyed. I would like to recognize and thank our staff for all the planning and setup required to pull this off, as well as the hard

work put in to make sure these events ran smoothly.

Now that our largest event is behind us, we are back on completing some of our current projects. We are working on the new member lounge area in the Community Center. We have been talking about this project for some time. Having to move things around to create the space needed took some work and planning. As we collaborate with the Planning Committee on layout and color scheme, we are steadily moving forward. Check out our facebook page for updates this month on the progress.

We have removed a diseased Cottonwood tree from fishing area 1 and another dead tree from fishing



area 9 including stump grinding. We have installed 10 new blue picnic tables at the West Beach and have replaced the broken and worn out tables at the beach area. We now have 20 picnic tables available at the beach.

### Outline for the MLP projects is as follows:

MLP Project phase 1 on schedule.

- Off leash areas now just waiting for hydro seed.
- Concrete entry poured
- Community Center ADA entrance complete
- New ADA parking as required are installed and complete
- New concrete side walk along rolling ridge complete
- Installing 150,000 sq. ft. of irrigation under construction on east side of park.
- Part of the phase boundary concrete path installed

- Ball field construction
- Walking path
- Flat work
- Cypress tree
- Shade trees
- 9 more shade structures
- Exercise station area
- Hydro seed

### OUR LAKE



There is a lot of information around about our lake. The Lake committee also had a Town Hall meeting last month to give a report on their findings and conclusion for addressing their findings.

This information is available on our website under the Amenities/Lake tab. Our lake is currently having a brown algae bloom. Our lake is safe for recreation use. Recently, we did post a cautionary advisement regarding not drinking the water from the lake and do not let pets drink from the water at areas you see scum on the shore line. This advisory was posted as one of the tests came back with .005mg/L of anatoxin-a, which is a byproduct of blue-green algae. Of the samples taken around the lake, only 1 sample showed this result. So we caution you to stay away from the green scum at the lakes edge. Our swim beach area is separate from lake, but feeds fresh water into the lake, which is why we consistently pump fresh well water into the swim beach area. The water is tested every week as required by the Health Department, and the findings are reported to them weekly. Our samplings are well within the health departments requirements. Here are the last nutrient results from the lake samples.

**Country Club Theft**

On Saturday, July 29, Public Safety received information that an individual had stolen personal property at the Spring Valley Lake Country Club. Officer I. Kelly and Officer A. Rangel quickly responded to the location of the individual and they were able to locate the suspect in question wearing a blue backpack and carrying one of the stolen items. The Public Safety Department contacted the San Bernardino Sheriff's Department and notified them of the location of the suspect. Both Officers spoke with the suspect in question and convinced the suspect to return the items that had been stolen. Public Safety wasn't finished there; they continued to check the surrounding areas of the golf course and located more stolen items in a pond on the golf course. Public Safety was able to successfully return the stolen items to the original owners.

The Spring Valley Lake Public Safety Department works with local law enforcement to provide the best services we can when handling calls that are out of

our jurisdiction. Though we are sometimes limited as to what we can do, we will do all we can to promote a safe environment for our community. **New AED**

I am the utmost excited to inform you that our Public Safety Department has upgraded our (AED) automated electronic defibrillators! Not only are they more cost efficient, but they have been integrated with a new key system that allows public safety to utilize the same AED pads for both infant and adult victims experiencing cardiac arrest. These newly upgraded AEDs are expected to minimize delays in attaching the appropriate pads to victims. I am a certified CPR instructor and I passionately train my officers to learn how to perform high quality CPR with a sense of purpose.

All public safety officers are professionals in performing high quality CPR. The Spring Valley Lake Public Safety Department has been granted the privilege of serving this wonderful community. One way we provide our services is responding to medical emergencies that occur within the boundaries of Spring Valley Lake. In the unfavorable event
