





Happy New Year!

The beginning of a new year is an opportune time to identify challenges and set goals, including:

*Establishing short and long term plans for the improvement of the lake quality.

*Navigating the new application and approval requirements for any chemical treatments of the lake.

*Repairing parts of the eroded lake liner and planning and budgeting for future lake liner maintenance.

*Evaluating the rules regarding vessels permitted on the lake with regard to impact on water quality and infrastructure.

*Finding cost-effective methods beyond courtesy notices and citations to achieve the required maintenance of properties so that houses in the neighborhood retain or increase in value. These methods may include friendly solution-finding discussions between the General Manager and the homeowners. Serious non-compliance issues will be evaluated for legal action.

*Planning and budgeting for future phases of the park renovation and the sprucing up of other amenities.

*Reaching out to busy property owners and getting them to take time to give their valued input regarding Spring Valley Lake issues.

*Attracting qualified board and committee members interested in investing their time and energy into making decisions in the best interests of the Association membership.

What are your goals for Spring Valley Lake and how can you help to achieve them?

Your General Manager, Alfred Logan, does not limit goal setting to the beginning of the year. He listens to homeowner concerns and identifies solutions. He meets regularly with his leadership team and staff to jointly establish goals and develop measurable targets. - (c) That members serve for two year terms and may

only serve for two consecutive terms.

(d) That the only qualification for members of the Board is that they be voting members (property owners) in good standing.

Here we are in 2019, and having beautiful weather, but freezing! No matter where you go, you have to bundle up to stay warm. Please don't forget your pets outside in this cold weather.



Make sure you have drained your swamp coolers or the pipes will bust.

Drain your water hoses also to keep them from cracking. This freezing weather is brutal on equipment and tools left outside.

All Christmas decorations need to be taken down by January 31, 2019. We will start inspecting after February 1 to make sure that all decorations are down.



We will still be nagging you about the trash cans in the New Year! Please put them where they belong so that it is not on the street or in view from the street. If it is in plain view....you will receive a notice.

We are still receiving many calls about vehicles parked on the streets. We do understand your frustration, because we also be-



come frustrated over the issue. Yes, we have a rule that covers this violation, but California Highway Patrol tells us we have no jurisdiction for vehicles left in the street. The streets belong to the County. When you see vehicles parked on the street, you must contact CHP dispatch and give them all the information. Their number is (760) 241-1186 or in the evenings (760) 256-1617. When we see cars that have been in a place for some time, we take photos and send them to CHP. We have had one or two towed by CHP. Persistence is the key.

Many calls come in about leaves. Every tree in the community is dropping its leaves. If you do not have a tree in your yard, but you are getting leaves, speak to your neighbor about the issue. You might be able to come to a peaceful conclusion. If you cannot, then call us.

If you have received a notice for not having the proper license and documentation for your tenants please submit them as soon as possible. The application for a dwelling license is to be submitted to the County of San Bernardino. They do not accept walk in payments. The payment may only be



mailed to one of their three various locations. Once your license is obtained from the county, you can send a copy of the license and crime free lease addendum to the Association office. We do not accept applications or pay-

ment receipts.




PROJECTS AROUND THE COMMUNITY

Happy New Year Spring Valley Lake, we are excited and looking forward to 2019. Year 2018 brought on some great projects and improvements in our community: We have started and completed Phase 1 of the Meadowlark park project; Installed new benches at the front of the CB; Installed shade structures and drinking fountains that are pet friendly at some of our fishing areas; and Installed exercise equipment at 5 of our fishing areas that were donated by Heritage Victor Valley Medical Group. We also did a lake treatment, repaired west beach, added trout, sunfish, crappie, minnows, shiners and crayfish to encourage a healthy fishery and food chain, as well as installed artificial fish habitats round the lake. We replaced the EQ gazebo with new picnic areas and a horse statue. At the EQ, we installed new gates. We replaced the Public Safety and Code Enforcement fleet as well as auctioned off the old fleet; just to name a few projects completed in 2018.

We have also worked on updating our standard operating procedures for our Maintenance department and said goodbye to a great employee, Joey Duran, who

has decided to move onto better opportunities for himself and his family. Joey has worked with us since 2006 and he has proven himself as an excellent employee. He will be missed, but we are glad to see him pursue better opportunities. Since then, we have added a new employee to our team and started with some quick projects this month.

We have just finished removing 2 dying cypress trees from the west beach and we will be replacing it with a new tree this spring. Some broken concrete was replaced at fishing area 3 and dog drink-



ing fountains installed at our dog parks. We just completed redoing the base at our main arena. The contractor pulled the sand back to reveal the base in the arena was an 11 inch deep bowl preventing the water to drain correctly. It took 550 tons of decomposed granite to repair the issue; and an additional 125 tons of sand to get our arena into prime shape. This was a reserve item, and with proper care, we look forward to many more years of use before this item is up on our reserve again. Our maintenance staff just completed training for basic horsemanship, houseclean and arena grading.

Lake Side

We have started lowing the lake. We will enforce a no wake throughout the entire lake starting on February 3, 2019. Just as a reminder, we lower the lake not by draining more water, but by adjusting our pumping. We will lower the amount of water we pump into the lake from our wells as each day we receive continuous water from the Country Club in the amount of about 2.4 million gallons. We also release about 2.3 million gallons per day to the Majove Narrows Regional Park. Because it is winter, we are only losing about 1.6 million to mostly evaporation and this is why we can lower the lake without increasing the outflow.

You will also see us out on the lake performing

our normal buoy maintenance. We inspect all buoys for cracks and identification and operation of the solar lights. This will include removing the buoy so that we can make any necessary repairs. Each buoy will then be replaced at its correct locations.

We expect to start work on the liner repairs the week of February 18, 2019. These repairs have been prioritized from a liner study the Association did in 2013. We will re-evaluate the priority list and work on areas by priority of condition. These repairs will be scheduled every other year as structured per our reserves. We will be in contact with the home owners that will be directly affected by the repairs. We will keep the information and details flowing out from all of our media sources until we complete the work in March of 2019.
