



## **GRUB CLUB INFORMATION**

### **What is Grub Club?**

Grub Club is a weekly event where SVLA invites a food vendor to park on Association property and sell directly to residents. Grub Club takes place every Thursday from 5-8:30pm. During the summer, vendors are invited to park at the beach area from 11am-2:30pm on Saturdays.

Saturday Grub Club only takes place during the months of June, July, and August.

### **Where does Grub Club take place?**

Every Thursday, vendors will park at Meadowlark Park (12975 Rolling Ridge Dr.) and during the summer they can park at the Beach Area (13230 Country Club Dr.)

### **What do we require from vendors?**

SVLA needs to see a copy of the following paperwork:

- CA Seller's Permit
- Food Preparation Permit (TFF or MFF) from San Bernardino County
- Insurance with SVLA listed as additional insured along with our mailing address: 7001 SVL Box, Victorville, CA 92395

Paperwork must be submitted a minimum of 48 hours before first appearance. Once all paperwork is received, SVLA will issue an event application where you can specify which dates you want to attend. Grub Club dates can only be booked two at a time, this is to make sure the community gets a good variety throughout the months. (For example, if multiple dates are available, the vendor can only select two from the list presented). Periodically, SVLA will reach out with available dates, but vendors are always welcome to call or email and see what is available.

SVLA also requests a digital logo and menu so it can be added to the event flyers and social media posts (*P.S. SVLA Residents prefer if the menu has pricing included*).

### **What happens if I cancel?**

If a vendor must cancel their appearance, SVLA requires at least 24 hours' notice so they can find a different vendor to take your place. If something happens and you cannot give 24 hours' notice, please call and notify SVLA at the earliest moment. SVLA does not tolerate a no call, no show; if you no call, no show you will be removed from the vendor list and will not be invited back.

SVLA understands that accidents happen, if you break down or are involved in a car accident let them know as soon as you are up and running again. SVLA also understands that sometimes



there's traffic and you'll be late. If you believe you will be late, please call and notify SVLA so that they are aware and can inform their residents.

### **I have turned in my paperwork and selected a date, what's next?**

The week of your first appearance, you will receive an email from SVLA with basic information including: an address, where to park, and what time to set up. Since the location of Grub Club never changes, you will only receive this email for your first appearance as SVLA will assume that you will remember where to go for any additional appearances.

### **Who is the point of contact for SVLA events and Grub Club?**

The Community Engagement Specialist is the person who handles all events and booking vendors.
