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Fellow Spring Valley Lake Association community members,

My lovely bride and I have a new pastime, which we enjoy mostly on the weekends, which is driving to the SVLA beach and sitting in our beach chairs relaxing.

We've always loved "people watching" in New England, and sitting within our community in such a peaceful and serene environment, hearing children playing and adults conversing just really makes our evening.

During these times, we've made a few observations that I wanted to share with you.

On one occasion, there was a young man strolling up and down the beach. What struck me about him was how he was picking up trash as he walked. As I had been watching him for a bit, I knew that the litter he was picking up wasn't his – it was blowing across the sand to the water, and he took it upon himself to help keep the beach clean.

On one of those passes, I stopped him and introduced myself. He had a firm handshake and seemed that he was surprised that someone would notice his good deed and thank him for what he was doing. So, Yurio, if you or your parents are reading this, I just wanted to say "thank you" again for being a good person, and a great community member. And to your parents, well done. You raised a good young man.

While scrolling on my Facebook feed, we saw a post from Devon, who made mention that someone hadn't cleaned up after themselves at one of the fishing areas. The picture showed that some fish had been cleaned, but the area was left quite a mess. Reading his post, Devon mentioned that he had cleaned the area and asked that people respect our community. He took his own time, and effort, to help keep our community beautiful. I commented on that post but wanted to again thank Devon for his actions.

Each day we're there, a few boats pull up and anchor on the beach to pick up friends, drop friends off, or allow their children to play. One boat owner was having difficulty pushing his boat back into the lake, and before I was able to get up from my chair to go help him, the boat owner who had just pulled up next to him rushed over to help. With their combined effort, the boat was pushed back, and there were quick exchanges of "thanks". Again, one neighbor helping another.

We do try to interact with the association staff, as we are constantly seeing lifeguards and public safety patrols, and struck up a conversation with a staff member who let us know that we have a "hero" in public safety. It seems a resident had called in earlier in the day to dispatch explaining that there was a large turtle in the road

and they didn't know what to do. Well, our public safety officer responded and relocated the turtle to the lake. After clearing the scene, I heard that the dispatcher called the officer "their hero." Kindness goes a long way.

These are all great things that have happened in our association, but I did leave one part out... All these things happened in the span of 4 hours on July 19th. In just 4 hours, we have multiple people helping each other, helping our community, and trying to make our "Jewel of the High Desert" continue to be a great place to live.

We all seem to focus on the negatives at times, and research has shown that we are much more likely to leave a bad review than a good one for restaurants, services, etc. Even our Facebook pages of late have had their fair share of complaints, but I ask that we not forget that while there are certainly things that could be improved about Spring Valley Lake Association, this is still a great place to live, and a fantastic community who care deeply about and for each other.

I also wanted to make mention of our newly re-invigorated Equestrian Estates committee. The new leadership team canvassed a few streets on the EQ side and had a whopping 25 people show up to their committee meeting to provide needed input to the committee and then to the board on what needs to be addressed. Their efforts are working, and the board was asked to address the arena floor, the exit gate, and the bridges. Both the arena floor and gate repairs were approved, and the board has asked the general manager to get us quotes on fixing the bridges. Another shining example of how when people unite for positive change, great things can happen.

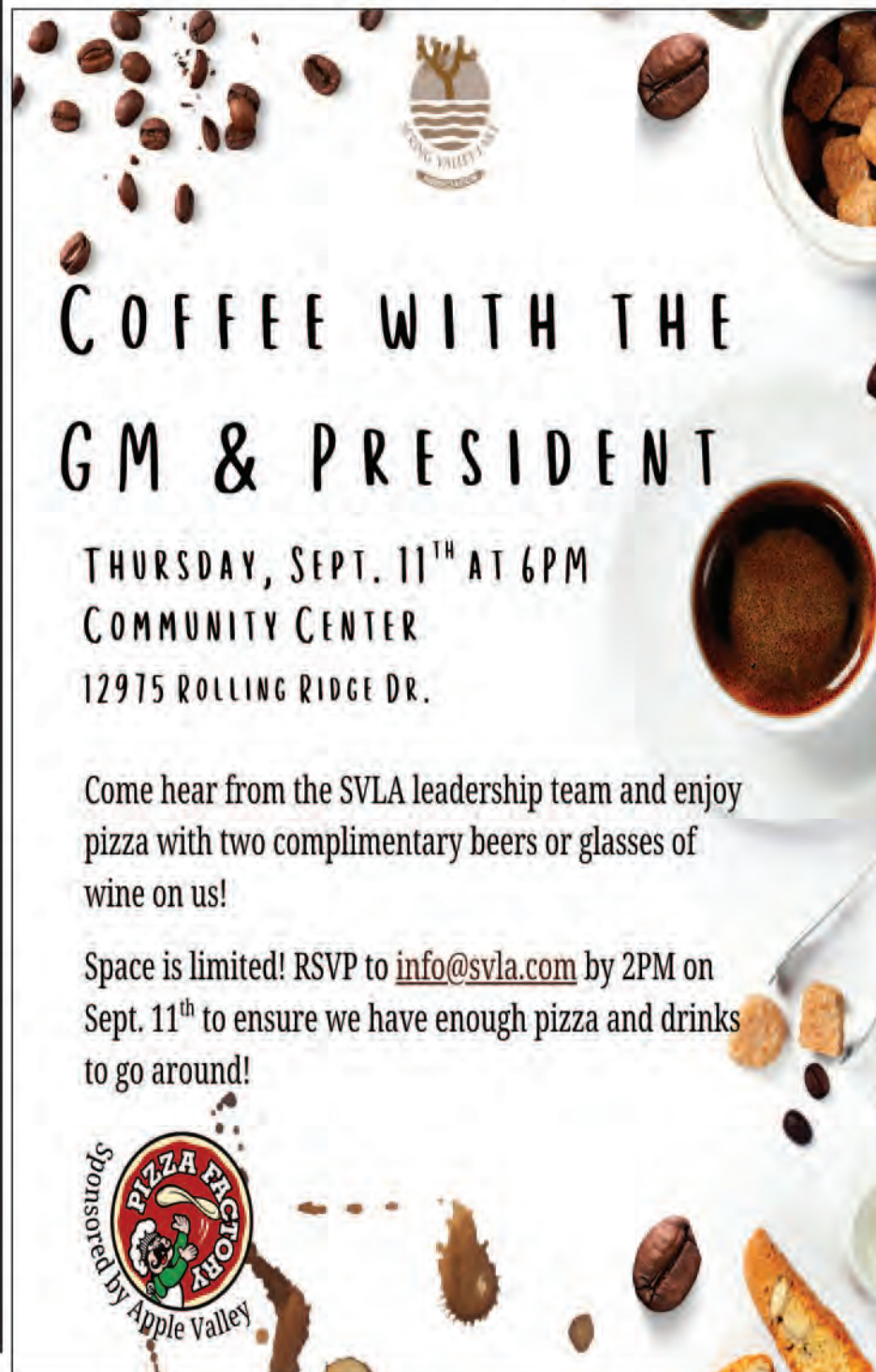

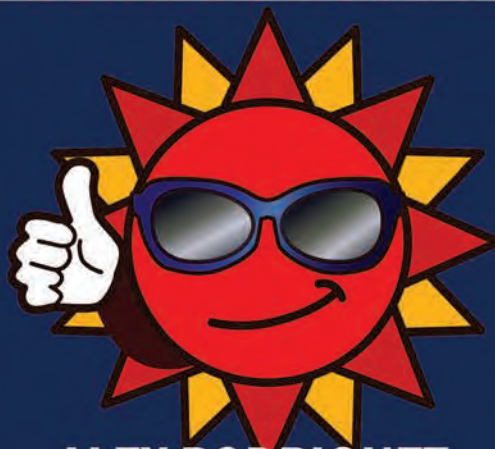

August Maintenance & Community Update

As the summer season continues, we remain committed to keeping Spring Valley Lake a clean, safe, and welcoming place for all residents and visitors. Below are the latest updates on community projects and efforts designed to enhance your experience and protect our beautiful surroundings.

Equestrian Area Updates

The Board of Directors has approved several improvements in the Equestrian area, including the full renovation of the riding Arenas footing base. This project is currently in the planning phase and will provide a more functional and improved space for our equestrian residents. Additionally, started gathering pricing for



needed repairs and upgrades to the bridges along the Equestrian trails. These enhancements aim to improve long-term safety and accessibility throughout the area. The existing exit gate is being replaced and will help increase security and ease of access for riders and guests. More details on

timelines and construction activity will be shared in the coming weeks.

Fishing Area 9 / Pump Station Odor Concern

Recently, the Association responded to a complaint from a property owner regarding a foul odor near Fishing Area 9, located next to the County-operated pump station. Staff contacted a representative from San Bernardino County to report the concern and to inform them that the Air Quality Management District (AQMD) had already visited the site. During a follow-up discussion, the County official confirmed that the County's Project Management team had spoken with AQMD. As a result, the County has agreed to increase the frequency of pipe cleanings in the area to help reduce future odors. However, it was noted that despite these efforts, there is no guarantee the odor will be fully eliminated. The Association will continue to monitor the situation and work with the County to ensure the issue is being addressed as effectively as possible.

We appreciate your continued cooperation and support as we work to maintain a clean, safe, and enjoyable environment for all who live in and visit Spring Valley Lake. We look forward to sharing more progress and updates as the season continues.

- Dog waste must be cleaned up by their owners IMMEDIATELY.

- Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times.

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As we move into the heart of summer, I'd like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued partnership in keeping Spring Valley Lake a beautiful, safe, and welcoming community for all who call it home. The warm months often bring increased activity—both recreational and residential—so I'd like to share a few timely reminders and updates from our Code Enforcement team.

With higher temperatures and drier conditions, August is a critical month for weed abatement and brush clearance. Overgrown vegetation not only detracts from neighborhood aesthetics but also presents a serious fire hazard. Please ensure your property is well-maintained, with lawns frequently watered, trimmed, weeds removed, and no excessive debris near structures. Our team continues to conduct proactive inspections and appreciates your prompt compliance with any notices issued and thank you for your efforts in keeping up your property. We have had to spend over fifty thousand dollars in legal fees to gain compliance from owners who have refused to make corrections.

If you're planning any exterior improvements, including new

landscaping, fences, or home additions, please be sure to submit your plans and Architectural Application before starting the project. Our goal is to help you through the process smoothly and to ensure your project complies with SVLA standards. We are happy to meet with you and go over your application for any potential pitfalls.

We know enforcement isn't just about rules—it's about banning together to help the whole community look great and raise property values. Every code we uphold contributes to the overall quality of life in Spring Valley Lake. Our team is here to support residents, answer questions, and help resolve issues in a fair and respectful manner. If you ever receive a courtesy notice or have questions about community standards, we encourage you to reach out directly to code@svla.com. We're happy to help.

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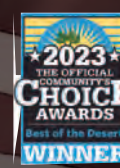
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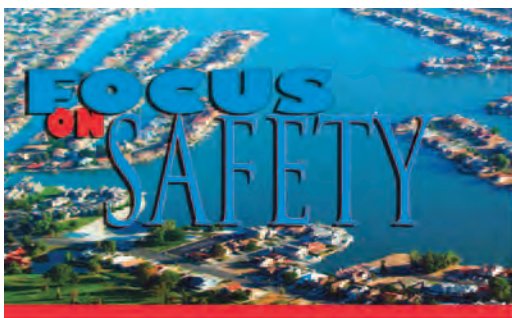

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Stay Safe During Lightning Storms

Late summer and fall bring more storms know the signs and protect yourself:

As late summer gives way to fall, lightning storms are becoming more frequent across the region. With millions of lightning strikes recorded each year in the United States, it's more important than ever to understand the dangers and know how to stay safe.

Lightning is a powerful natural force capable of reaching temperatures over 50,000 degrees Fahrenheit, hotter than the surface of the sun. On average, there are 25 million lightning strikes each year in the U.S. alone.

Recognize the Warning Signs

The first step in protecting yourself is being able to recognize an incoming lightning storm. Look for:

- Dark, gray clouds approaching
- Flashes of light in the distance
- The sound of thunder—if you can hear it, you are close enough to be struck

For current safety guidelines and local updates, visit the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) at lightningsafety.noaa.gov.

Water Safety is Critical

Being in or near water during a lightning storm is extremely dangerous. So please remember that the lifeguards at the beach area will take every precaution to keep the residents safe.

- Lifeguards may issue a long, loud whistle blast to evacuate swimmers
- If necessary, the entire beach may be cleared for safety
- Public safety officers will activate a wailing lake siren to signal immediate evacuation from all water and boats
- Once the storm has passed, a steady, continuous lake siren will indicate it is safe to resume lake and beach activities

Please follow all instructions from Public Safety personnel. They are there to help you.

Indoors Isn't Risk-Free

While sheltering indoors is safer, lightning can still pose a threat. If lightning strikes your home, it can travel through:

- Electrical wiring
- Plumbing
- Phone and TV cables

Avoid taking showers, using sinks, or handling electronics during a storm. Even indoors, light-

ning can cause burns or electrical injuries.

Caught Outdoors? Stay Low and Stay Safe

If you cannot reach shelter, take immediate precautions:

- Stay away from isolated tall objects like trees, poles, and light fixtures
- Avoid elevated areas such as lifeguard towers, ladders, or playgrounds
- Find a low-lying open space, and crouch down with your feet

together, balancing on the balls of your feet. Do not lie flat.

When Thunder Roars, Go Indoors Always wait at least 30 minutes after the last clap of thunder before returning outside.

Lightning may be awe inspiring, but it is also deadly. With proper awareness and swift action, you can help ensure your safety and the safety of those around you during every storm.

COMMUNITY SECURITY DISCLAIMER

The Spring Valley Lake Association ("SVLA") is a nonprofit corporation formed to manage and maintain all property owned by it and/or under its control. In connection with those responsibilities, the SVLA Public Safety Department ("PSD") has as its core purpose the protection of the SVLA common area amenities. The work it performs generally includes observing and reporting from public streets and SVLA common areas to enforce the Association's rules and other governing documents. SVLA is not a law enforcement entity, nor is it responsible for protecting people from third-party criminal conduct. While the presence of PSD personnel may assist in deterring crime, as well as the reporting of incidents to local law enforcement, that is not their focus.

Members and residents are ultimately responsible for protecting themselves and their property from criminal conduct. It is not reasonable to rely on the PSD to do so. Any concerns regarding potential criminal activity that may be taking place within SVLA should immediately be reported to local law enforcement. 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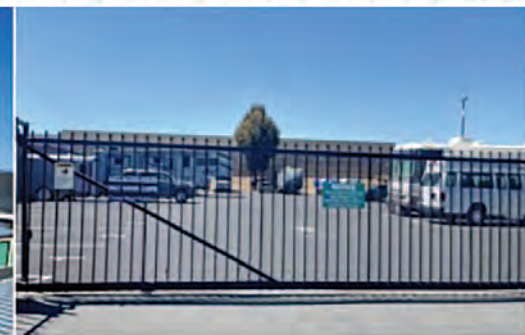
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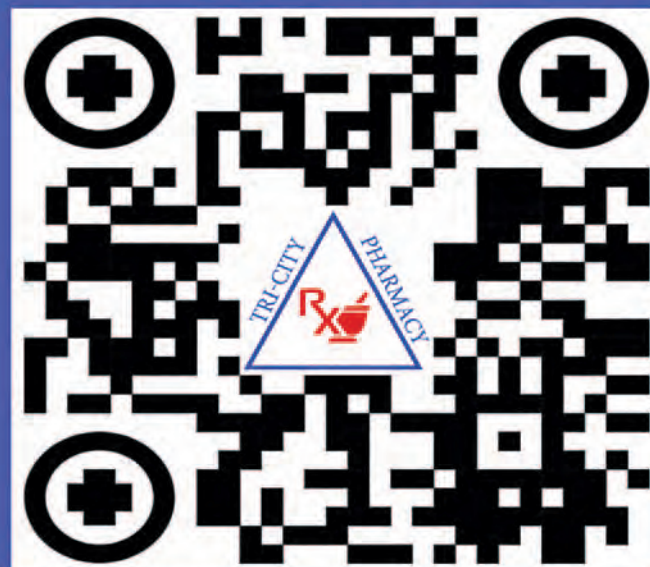
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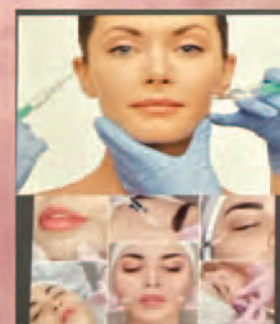
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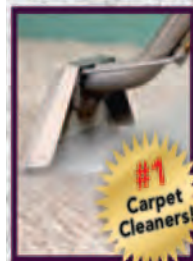
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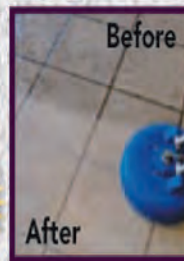
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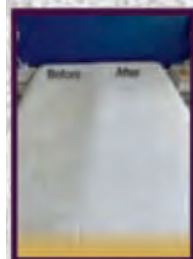
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***Community Meeting Notice:
Potential Entrance Arch Removal Project
Spring Valley Lake Advisory Council
July 7, 2025***

The Spring Valley Lake **Municipal Advisory Council (MAC)** voted 5-0 on June 16, 2025 to explore funding opportunities and timeline for the demolition of the archway.

Residents are encouraged to attend the July or August MAC meetings. **A town hall on this issue will be held at the Community Center on September 13 @ 10:00AM.** You may also email us at springvalleylake.mac@gmail.com, with any questions or comments on this project.

- The Arch is owned by the CSA-64 and is in poor condition.
- There has been very little maintenance on the Arch and its appearance does not project the appearance that the people of Spring Valley Lake would like.
- The Arch was constructed as a temporary structure over 50 years ago and there is concern whether or not it is structurally sound.
- Funding of this project if approved will come from the county and not from SVLA.
- The cost of refurbishing the Arch is considerably more than a demolition.

The MAC meets the third Wednesday of each month at the SVL Community center at 6:00pm in the Parkview Room. The next 2 meetings are July 16 and August 20

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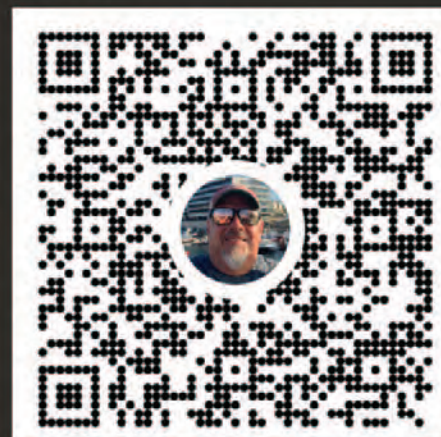
