



I hope everyone's new year is getting off to a great start! The association is working hard getting the coving repairs completed for this year; and I'm confident that the lake will be re-opened on time for boating in early May. We had a great discussion with residents at the last board meeting regarding the coving repairs. How the lots were selected for repair and costs associated with this project were discussed. The association will be developing a comprehensive plan now that we have been able to view the damage below the water line, for the next time we lower the lake.

The Board of Directors' election is coming up; and the deadline for placing your name on the ballot is February 10, 2023, by 3pm. Once the new Board is elected, all

committee members will need to re-apply for their committees by early May. I urge anyone considering running for the board to join a committee. This will benefit the community in many ways. First, we always need folks to participate at the committee level. This is important work that comes from the members and is overseen by the board. Secondly, members who run for the board, who have previously volunteered at the committee level, have a better understanding of how SVLA is governed. Lastly, being on a committee can give you a leg up when running for the Board of Directors, as folks will know who you are and what you stand for.

## C o v i n g   R e p a i r Update

An Executive Board meeting took place on Thursday,  
January 5, 2023 @ 6:00 PM via ZOOM.

The Board of Directors have approved and will finalize contracts with Victorville Concrete for work on 17 lots, and LPC Inc. for work on Fishing Area #7 and 3 lots.

The work should be completed approximately 45 days after approval. It will take approximately 90 days to fill our lake back to normal.

SVLA's maintenance team will be completing coving work on approximately 20 lots

Unforeseen weather may postpone the estimated completion date.

The coving repair project will have an estimated total cost of \$746,000.

We will send out more information as it becomes available.

We hope everyone has been staying warm and staying dry through all the storms we have experienced. The rain and cold has not slowed us down as we have been hard at work all around the community. Our biggest project that we are currently focusing on is the coving repairs, and we are moving along. Look below to see all that has been happening around the community...

#### **Beach Area:**

- Sanitizing picnic tables and playground equipment daily
- Cut grass
- Removed broken tree branch from East Beach
- Painted picnic tables at East and West Beach
- Repainted beach columns
- Installed 2" post at East Beach for PWC

#### **Parks:**

- Sanitizing picnic tables and playground equipment daily
- Cut grass
- Repaired valve at dog park
- Added DG to bare dirt areas at Meadowlark Park
- Trimmed bushes at Meadowlark Park
- Repaired and painted picnic tables at Meadowlark Park
- Painted trim on water shed at Meadowlark Park

- Vinyl fencing at Playfair and Long Acres Park
- Built horseshoes at Playfair Park

#### **Equestrian Center:**

- Cut grass
- Completed ground cover outside EQ Clubhouse
- Repaired electrical for main arena lights
- Added rock to EQ landscaping
- Repaired electrical for arena lights
- Repaired and painted EQ trail bridge

#### **Fishing Areas:**

- Installed rod iron verticals at East Beach and CB
- Repaired security cameras
- Finished new containment gate on diesel fuel storage
- Removed all Christmas decorations

#### **Floating Islands:**

- Floating Islands at FA #3 & FA #12 are doing well. Aquatic plants are flowering and establishing

#### **Wells:**

- All wells are active

#### **Lake Filtration Systems:**

- Installed all diffusers on aeration systems

#### **Lake & Marina Dock Maintenance:**

- Retrieved lake data
- Skimmed Lake three times a week
- Repaired white buoy near FA #15
- Picked up debris along lake shoreline
- Installed stainless adjustment weir plate

- Coving repairs
- Prepared boats and barges for coving repairs



We would like to extend a warm welcome to our new Facilities Maintenance Manager, Erick Corcuera. Erick has an extensive background in the Maintenance field and has held many management positions in the past. He is coming to us from his most recent position as Facilities Manager at Solera. His time at Solera will be beneficial as he is coming into this position with knowledge of HOA management. He is very computer savvy as well, and we are looking forward to seeing all that he brings to our team.

The Operations Department is always working diligently on maintaining SVLA's stature as well as keeping up on regular training videos to ensure we are delivering the best service possible. We are in full swing with our coving repairs. Our contractors have 9 lots fully formed and ready for the rebar grid to be placed; 8 lots prepped and ready to be formed, and approximately 95% of the soil placed where they had to rebuild the shoreline at Fishing area 7 and 3 adjacent prop-

erties. Additionally, our Maintenance work has formed 9 lots that are ready for the rebar grid. We are still looking to be on track for our March 1, 2023 completion date.

Given that we stay on track with completion, we are projecting to begin raising the level of the lake on March 2, 2023. We will begin raising the lake approximately 1 inch per day and it will take approximately 90 days for it to reach full level.

In addition to the coving work that is being done, we have another crew of employees going around and removing trash and debris from the shoreline. We are also taking photos and video of every lake front property to have on file, as a complete assessment of the coving. As you can see, there is a lot of activity out there.

Phase 1 of the dock replacement is also underway, as our vendor has ordered supplies and has be-

gun building the frames. Once all the frames are built you will then see the frames and flotation devices being delivered to the marina and they will begin assembling. We are expecting to see the assembling and installation process begin early spring.
