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Fellow Spring Valley Lake Association community members,

For this month's article, as there has been a lot of discussion lately on how our properties look, how many weeds may be growing on our lots, etc, I wanted to share some data on our code enforcement efforts and the important work that team does.

Code enforcement is a small, but mighty, group of a director, 3 full time code enforcement officers, 2 part time seasonal officers, and an administrative assistant. They are tasked with patrolling our community and reminding our property owners of the baseline standards that exist in our architectural standards and rules and regulations. They also help manage our architectural standards along with the architectural committee.

They patrol our streets and the lakefront properties to view areas on our properties that are visible from a public space that must have these standards applied.

Some statistics (as of June 25, 2025):

- Total open architectural applications: 360
- Architectural applications opened this past month: 90

- Architectural applications closed in the last month: 95
- Total violations cited: 151
- Total Cites going to July CRC meeting: 86
- Total Violations opened: 332
- Total Violations Closed: 299
- Total violations ready for reinspection (Were they remediated?): 170
- Total violations in process: 542 (318 of these are for weeds alone)

The team does quite a bit more than just citation work, but this is where much of the focus has been lately. I hope you'll agree that the team is very busy!

I do want to remind the community though, that while we cannot share which homes have been cited, by the sheer numbers above you'll see that there are a bunch of them... Let's work together, and even help our neighbors, if necessary, to keep our community looking great!

Thank you, Code Enforcement!!

At our open session last night, the board voted to uphold the by-laws section 10.1(a), which deals with the parking of recreational vehicles on a driveway for more than 72 hours. The by-laws prohibit this activity, and the only way

this will be able to be changed is with a vote of at least 66% of the membership. As I mentioned in last month's article, it's critical to start getting our entire community involved if the community wants this rule nullified. Again, please start talking to your neighbors, get your contact information corrected as needed at the association office, so your ballot arrives at the right place, and VOTE when it's time to do so. Your board is diligently working to try to get the by-laws, CC&R's, and Rule and Regulations updated to modern standards, but we cannot accomplish this without our community's involvement, and vote. We will need at least 2,782 votes for any change to occur here, something we have not seen in a long while.

There was a survey sent out to the community on this topic, and it seems that about 60% of the survey respondents support the concept of parking vehicles such as

boats and RVs on driveways year round, so rally your neighbors if this rule is something you'd like changed!

In closing, I want to again thank all of you, but also specifically Lisa Falcetti. Lisa is leaving our SVLA family after dedicating over 16 years of her life to helping keep our community safe. She started out working as a dispatcher in 2009 and worked her way up through the ranks to direct our public safety team. She's been a beacon of reliability, professionalism, and honesty. Lisa, thank you so very much for your service to our community, and we wish you well in your future endeavors. You've helped make Spring Valley Lake Association what it is today!

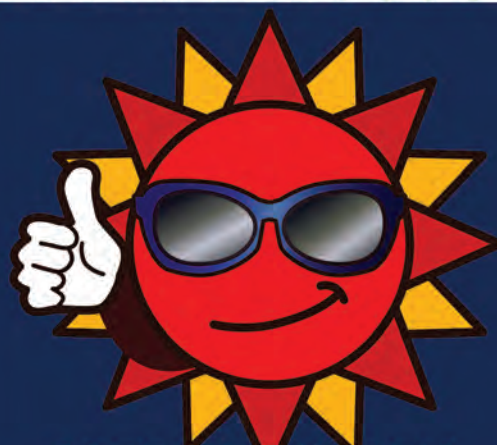

As the summer season unfolds, we remain committed to keeping Spring Valley Lake a clean, safe, and welcoming place for all residents and visitors. Below are the latest updates on maintenance projects and lakefront care designed to enhance your experience and protect our beautiful community.

V-Ditch Repairs in the Equestrian Area

The Board of Directors has approved the much-needed repairs to the V-ditch wall in the Equestrian area. This work is scheduled to begin shortly and will significantly improve drainage while helping to reduce erosion along the ditch. Residents may notice minor detours along the trail or hear construction activity during daytime hours, but every effort will be made to minimize disruptions. These improvements are an important investment in the long-term maintenance and safety of our community infrastructure.

Beach Area

As part of our routine summer maintenance, the Association conducts leech control treatments specifically at the beach swimming area to help reduce leech activity and provide a more comfortable experience for resi-

dents and guests.

These treatments involve the application of a safe, targeted chemical designed to deter leeches in shallow water. All applications are performed in accordance with safety guidelines and are limited strictly to the beach swim zone.

To ensure the treatment is effective and safe:

- The beach will close every Wednesday at 5:00 p.m.
- It will reopen the following morning.

During this time, please stay out of the water and avoid the treated areas.

In addition to the treatment, our team also performs shoreline cleanup during this window to remove any debris and maintain a tidy beach environment.

We appreciate your understanding as we continue these efforts to help ensure a cleaner and more enjoyable beach area for the community.

A Note About Leeches

Some residents have recently expressed concerns after noticing leeches in shallow areas of the lake. It's important to under-

stand that the presence of leeches is a normal and natural part of a healthy freshwater ecosystem like Spring Valley Lake. While their appearance may be unpleasant, most leech species found here are completely harmless. They tend to appear in warm, shallow waters where aquatic life is abundant. If a leech attaches to the skin, it can be gently removed by sliding a fingernail or credit card under its mouth—there's no

need to use salt, heat, or chemicals, which can cause additional irritation. Wearing water shoes, staying active while wading, and drying off immediately after swimming can help prevent unwanted encounters.

We appreciate your continued cooperation and hope everyone enjoys a clean, safe, and relaxing summer at Spring Valley Lake.

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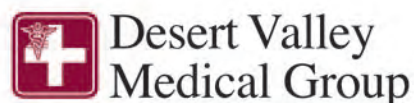

As we enter the peak of summer, the Code Enforcement department would like to thank all residents for their continued efforts in maintaining the high standards of our community. July is a time when outdoor activity increases and property maintenance becomes especially important. We're sharing a few seasonal reminders to help keep our neighborhood looking its best and in full compliance with HOA guidelines.

With warmer weather, lawn and landscape maintenance take on increased importance. Homeowners are reminded to mow regularly, as grass that exceeds the acceptable height can quickly become unsightly and attract unwanted pests. Along with mowing, weed control around flower beds, driveways, and sidewalks should be kept up to prevent overgrowth. Shrubs and trees should also be trimmed to avoid obstructing sidewalks or creating visibility concerns near streets and intersections.

Proper trash management is another focus this month. Trash bins must be stored out of public view except on collection days. This means keeping them in the garage or behind approved fencing when not in use. Leaving items curbside for extended periods is not permitted and may lead to citations.

Home exterior upkeep is especially important during the summer months. Residents should take this opportunity to power wash surfaces, touch up peeling paint, and address any signs of structural

wear. Driveways and sidewalks should also be kept clean and in good condition—free from debris, stains, and cracks that could pose safety hazards or detract from curb appeal.

As for vehicles, please make sure all cars parked on your property are operable and properly licensed. Vehicles should be parked in appropriate areas, never on lawns, rocks, or sidewalks.

With Independence Day approaching, we encourage residents to display patriotic decorations as part of the celebration. However, please remember to remove all holiday-specific decorations by August 4 in order to remain within seasonal decor guidelines.

Lastly, if you observe any potential violations or areas of concern, we encourage you to report them through the HOA's SVLA LIVING APP. Submissions can be made confidentially and can include photos when possible as it is helpful to our review process.

Thank you for your ongoing cooperation and commitment to keeping our neighborhood safe, beautiful, and enjoyable for everyone. 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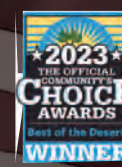
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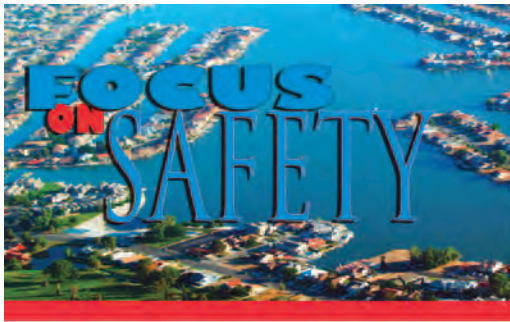
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Hello Spring Valley Lake Community,

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Protect your Belongings

With warmer weather approaching, there's often a noticeable increase in opportunistic crime, particularly theft. It's important to take proactive steps to safeguard your belongings. Please take a moment to review these practical safety tips:

1. **Always Lock Your Vehicle** - Even if you're stepping away for just a moment, lock your car and activate the alarm (if equipped). A large percentage of vehicle thefts and break-ins occur because the car was left unlocked.
2. **Keep Valuables Out of Sight** - Never leave items visible in your vehicle. It only takes a second for a thief to smash a window and grab something left in plain view.
3. **Park Smart** - When possible, park your vehicle in your garage or driveway. Install motion-sensor lights and security cameras that provide clear visibility of your vehicle and property.
4. **Secure Truck Tailgates** - Tailgates can be removed quickly and easily if not locked. Make sure yours is secure when your truck is unattended.
5. **Dispose of Packaging Discreetly** - Avoid advertising recent high-value purchases by leaving boxes (e.g., TVs, electronics) on the curb. Break them down and place them inside your trash can.
6. **Lock All Entry Points** - Always secure doors, garage doors, windows, and side gates before going to bed or leaving your home. A locked gate can be a strong deterrent to someone looking to access your backyard.
7. **Don't Leave Temptations Outside** - Bring in items such as bicycles, scooters, tools, and delivered packages. These are easy targets when left in front yards or on porches.

If a theft or suspicious activity occurs, residents should call the **Sheriff Department at 760-956-5001** and then the Public Safety Department at 760-245-6400.

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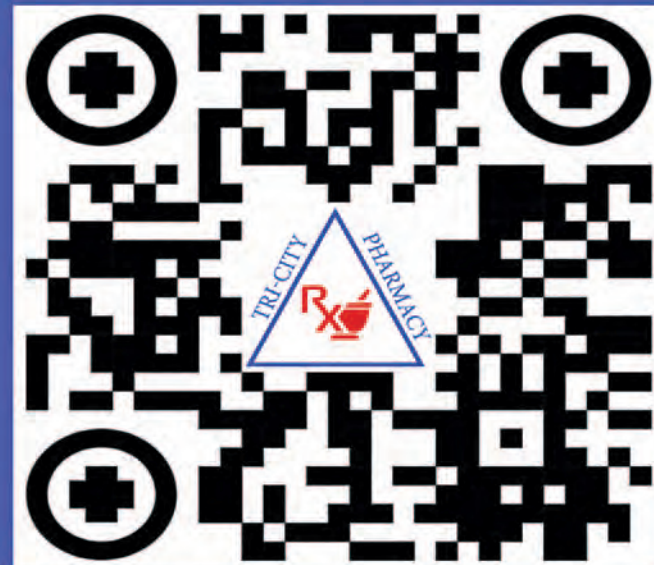


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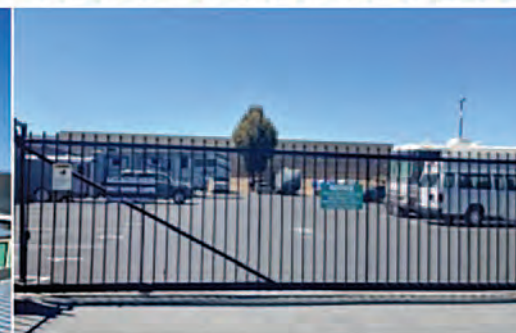

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***Community Meeting Notice:
Potential Entrance Arch Removal Project
Spring Valley Lake Advisory Council
July 7, 2025***

The Spring Valley Lake **Municipal Advisory Council (MAC)** voted 5-0 on June 16, 2025 to explore funding opportunities and timeline for the demolition of the archway.

Residents are encouraged to attend the July or August MAC meetings. **A town hall on this issue will be held at the Community Center on September 13 @ 10:00AM.** You may also email us at springvalleylake.mac@gmail.com, with any questions or comments on this project.

- The Arch is owned by the CSA-64 and is in poor condition.
- There has been very little maintenance on the Arch and its appearance does not project the appearance that the people of Spring Valley Lake would like.
- The Arch was constructed as a temporary structure over 50 years ago and there is concern whether or not it is structurally sound.
- Funding of this project if approved will come from the county and not from SVLA.
- The cost of refurbishing the Arch is considerably more than a demolition.

The MAC meets the third Wednesday of each month at the SVL Community center at 6:00pm in the Parkview Room. The next 2 meetings are July 16 and August 20

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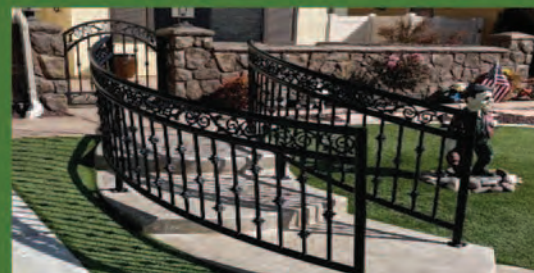

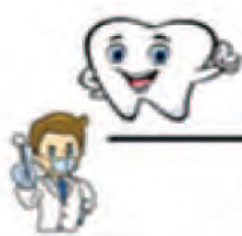
