THE FIRST 100 DAYS

A Community on the Move

There is real momentum building across Spring Valley Lake, and you can feel it. It is the energy that comes when people believe their community can be stronger, more connected, and more welcoming than ever before. Our **100 Day Plan** was created to turn that belief into action. From the beginning, the mission has been clear: Strengthen Spring Valley Lake from the inside out by improving **connection, communication, planning, and stewardship**, while creating more ways for residents to be involved in shaping the future of the place we call home.

Welcoming Every New Neighbor

One of the most exciting parts of this effort is our new **Welcoming Committee**. We want every new neighbor who comes to Spring Valley Lake to immediately feel seen, welcomed, and connected. Our vision is to meet every new resident, provide a welcome basket, assign them a **Neighbor Buddy**, take them on a tour of SVLA amenities, and encourage them to attend monthly Board meetings, events, and activities so they can quickly become part of community life. We do not want people to simply move here. We want them to feel like they belong here. We also hope that experience inspires them to

get involved on a committee themselves and help shape the kind of community they want to live in.

Helping Spring Valley Lake Feel Like Home

We are also reaching out to **local vendors and entrepreneurs** who live in the neighborhood and want to share their services with the community. We are inviting them to participate in our welcome baskets by donating a product, service, offer, or promotional item that helps introduce new residents to trusted local resources right away. I am also working with larger companies, municipalities, and local restaurants to participate as well. When people move in and immediately know who to call, where to go, and what is available around them, they settle in faster and feel connected sooner. This is about much more than saying "welcome." It is about helping people find their place here so Spring Valley Lake truly feels like home.

Neighbors Helping Neighbors

Another important piece of this growing momentum is our **Neighbors Helping Neighbors** program. This effort is rooted in a belief many of us already know to be true: one of the greatest strengths of Spring Valley Lake is the people who live here. We already have residents

willing to donate time, talent, and resources to help neighbors in need, and we plan to expand this effort in the months ahead. If you want to participate, whether by volunteering, sharing your skills, or helping support a neighbor going through a difficult time, please send me a message. This kind of generosity and hometown spirit is exactly what makes a community special.

Our Lake

Of course, no conversation about Spring Valley Lake would be complete without talking about the lake itself. Our lake is the heart of this community, and both the infrastructure and water clarity are being addressed. We are finalizing the RFP so that when the lake is lowered in September, we will have qualified bids ready to help finalize the repair plan for next year. This work matters deeply, and we want it done properly, transparently, and with qualified professionals. If you know a contractor who is skilled, licensed, bonded, and insured and would like the opportunity to bid on the project, please have them contact us so they can be added to the bid list and have the opportunity to submit a proposal.

Responsible Planning for a Stronger Future

Because we know the lake is a major and necessary investment, we are taking a hard look at how Association funds are being used. This year, we are using a **Zero Based Budget** approach to examine expenses from the ground up and make sure we are utilizing our resources in the best and most responsible way possible. Every dollar matters. Good stewardship

means preparing for the large projects that protect our future while also making wise decisions that allow us to preserve the traditions, amenities, and events that make Spring Valley Lake such a vibrant place to live.

Exceptional People

Spring Valley Lake is full of talented, experienced, and passionate people, and we need that energy. We know there are residents here with valuable skills in water management, finance, event planning, construction, communications, outreach, and more. We want your ideas, your experience, and your involvement. Committees are not side projects. They are one of the most important ways residents can help shape meaningful change in the community. If you have ever looked around and thought, "Someone should do something," this is your invitation to be part of that something.

Summer in Spring Valley Lake

And as summer begins, so does one of the best parts of life in Spring Valley Lake: coming together to enjoy the place we are all working so hard to strengthen. That includes our specialty events like the **Fireworks Show on June 27th** and our **Concerts at the Beach** series, which kicks off **June 5th with Lenore and That 80's Band**. Financial Stewardship in Action

Happy June, Spring Valley Lake!

As your current Treasurer, I am excited to share some of the important financial work already underway to help put Spring Valley Lake in a stronger position.

First, we are working diligently to get our financials corrected, up to date, and fully organized; that includes addressing issues we inherited from Consortium and making sure our records are accurate, reliable, and moving in the right direction. Financial integrity and transparency matter, and this work is essential to restoring confidence in our reporting and helping the Board make sound decisions.

We are also undertaking a **Zero Based Budget** this year to carefully analyze our costs and spending. That means we are not just rolling forward old numbers and old habits. We are taking a fresh look at expenses, evaluating where money is going, and identifying where we can do better. It is imperative that we reduce costs where possible by working with vendors, developing efficiencies, and investing in things that make Spring Valley Lake a safer and better place to live. This kind of disciplined review can help us protect the Association's financial future and keep assessments as low as reasonably possible.

One area already under review is **collections**, where we know

we can do better. We have already made a major change by switching to a collection vendor who only gets paid when money is actually collected, instead of the Association paying out large sums up front whether or not anything is recovered. Last month's collection bill alone was over **\$28,000**. That is not sustainable, and we are committed to finding smarter, more effective ways to manage these costs while still protecting the Association.

We are also working to bring **escrows in house**, which we believe will make a significant difference not only in reducing costs, but also in improving the homeowner experience. This is another example of looking for practical ways to operate more efficiently while providing better service to our members.

This work is ongoing. It is detailed, it is time-consuming, and it takes persistence. But we are committed to doing the hard work necessary to strengthen the Association's financial position, improve transparency, and keep more of your money working for the benefit of the homeowners of Spring Valley Lake.

Together, this is possible.

The Association has also recently partnered with a new collections agency that specializes in non-judicial foreclosure services. This partnership represents a significant improvement in how delinquent assessments are collected. Under our previous collection process, the Association was often required to pay substantial costs upfront in order to pursue collection efforts. These expenses were ultimately borne by the membership and placed an unnecessary financial burden on Association resources. Our new collections partner operates under a performance-based model, meaning they are compensated only when they successfully recover delinquent assessments and obtain payment in full from delinquent owners. This approach significantly reduces the Association's upfront costs while maintaining an effective collection program. As a result of this change, the Association anticipates saving ap-

In addition to these operational improvements, the Association's Accounting Department has begun work on the **2026-2027 Fiscal Year Budget**. This important process involves a comprehensive review of operating expenses, reserve funding requirements, contractual obligations, utility costs, and anticipated revenues to ensure the Association remains financially stable while continuing to provide the services and amenities our members expect. As part of the budget development process, staff and management are evaluating opportunities to improve efficiency, reduce unnecessary expenditures, and identify new revenue sources that can help offset operating costs. 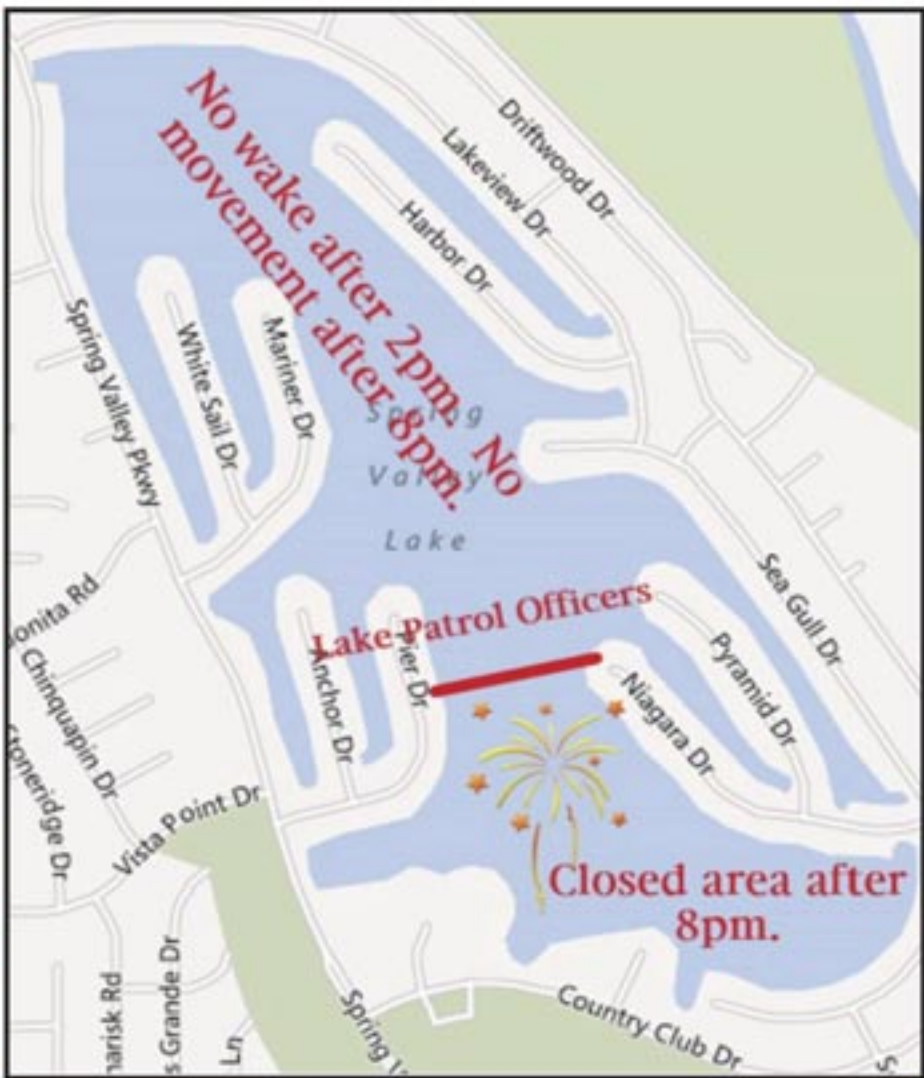

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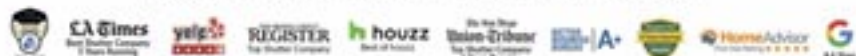

Operations and Project Updates Summary

Dear Spring Valley Lake Residents, I would like to provide a brief update on current Association operations, ongoing projects, and follow-up items being reviewed by staff.

In this role, my focus has been on reviewing current projects, resident concerns, maintenance needs, vendor communication, and open operational items to help keep Association matters moving forward. Residents with unresolved concerns or items needing follow-up may contact Maintenance at Maintenance@svla.com or submit a request through the SVLA Living App at: <https://www.svla.com/svla-living-app/>

Several facility and maintenance items have recently been completed or advanced, including temporary concrete crack repairs at the Community Building, updated maintenance procedures, and continued follow-up on facility projects.

Roofing work is also progressing. The Community Building and Maintenance building roof projects have been completed. Roofing at the Equestrian Center is now in the final phase, with the Equestrian barn areas completed and remaining roof-related items being finalized.

Lake operations remain an active focus. Staff continues reviewing water quality testing, aerator inspections, algae concerns, lake maintenance options, and other related follow-up items. Addi-

tional information is currently being gathered to support these efforts. A lake inspection device has also been received to assist with future inspections and improve visibility in hard-to-see areas. Staff will be assessing the device and how it can best support lake inspections moving forward.

Floating islands are being moved back to their designated Fishing Area locations, including FA #2, FA #3, FA #4, FA #5, FA #9, FA #10, and FA #13.

The pending lake coving project will continue through the planning process, including the next steps for engineering review and estimates. Planning is also continuing for the Administration Office ADA pathway.

The Equestrian Center bridge project is pending further direction after bids were received for review. The Equestrian Center restroom project is also moving forward, with plans submitted and pending final approval.

Park and recreation updates include completed grading, irrigation repairs, and hydroseeding at Fishing Area #9. Meadowlark Park termite treatment has been addressed with bait stations, and staff is gathering estimates for basketball court resurfacing. Staff will also be scheduling and adding additional sand to the beach areas as part of our ongoing seasonal maintenance.

Turf recovery and surface leveling needs at Long Acres Park, Playfair Park, and Equestrian Park areas are also being reviewed. Ad-

ditional gopher treatments and vendor estimates are being coordinated to address uneven turf and damaged areas. Grass areas are progressing well, and staff will continue making adjustments to watering times and irrigation coverage as needed.

Several in-house projects are

also moving forward, including the Community Center tree root curbing concept and the barge build. These projects are being developed with a focus on cost savings, safety, and long-term facility improvements.

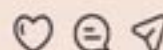

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CODE ENFORCEMENT

As summer begins and temperatures rise, June is an important time for residents to remain proactive in maintaining their homes and properties. Increased outdoor activity, rapid landscape growth, and hotter weather all bring seasonal considerations that can impact both the appearance and safety of our community.

Maintaining our neighborhood is a collective effort, and the actions taken by each homeowner contribute to preserving the quality, beauty, and value of the place we all call home.

With warmer weather and dry conditions approaching, landscape care becomes increasingly important. Residents are encouraged to remove weeds and dry vegetation regularly, keep lawns mowed and properly maintained, trim back overgrown shrubs and tree branches, and clear dead plant material from landscaping beds and around structures. Proper maintenance not only improves curb appeal but also helps reduce fire hazards during the summer months.

June often marks the beginning of increased irrigation use. Please take time to inspect your sprinkler and drip systems for broken or misaligned sprinkler heads, overspray onto sidewalks, neighboring properties, or streets, leaks or pooling water, and finally areas of overwatering or runoff. Efficient irrigation helps maintain healthy

landscaping while conserving water and preventing waste.

Summer is one of the busiest seasons for exterior home improvements. Before beginning any project, residents are reminded that exterior modifications require architectural approval prior to installation or construction, including:

- Patio covers and pergolas
- Exterior paint changes
- Fencing or wall modifications
- Solar panel installations
- Landscaping or hardscape changes

Submitting plans in advance helps avoid delays and ensures projects remain compliant with community standards.

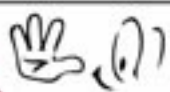
Our department remains committed to assisting homeowners in understanding and maintaining compliance with the community's standards. Many concerns can be prevented through regular upkeep and proactive planning.

Short-Term Rentals

Spring Valley Lake has long been valued as a peaceful residential community built around family living, neighborhood safety, and quality of life. In recent years, however, many full-time residents have become increasingly concerned about the rapid growth of short-term vacation rentals through platforms such as Airbnb.

One of the most common concerns involves excessive noise and disruptive behavior. Residents have reported loud late-night parties, amplified music, speeding vehicles, overcrowded homes, and constant turnover of unfamiliar guests. Unlike permanent residents who understand and follow community standards, short-term visitors often have little connection to the neighborhood or accountability to those living nearby.

Residents are encouraged to immediately contact the Spring Valley Lake Public Safety Department to report violations occurring within the community. Reporting incidents to Public Safety helps create official documentation of recurring problems and allows the Spring Valley Lake Association to investigate violations and hold property owners accountable for the actions of their renters and guests.

In addition, residents are strongly encouraged to submit complaints directly through Airbnb's Neighborhood Support system immediately, so Airbnb receives a first-hand account of the disturbances occurring within the community. First-person reports from impacted residents help document patterns of nuisance activity and provide Airbnb with direct evidence of excessive noise, unauthorized parties, parking violations, trespassing, overcrowding, unsafe behavior, and other disruptions affecting neighborhood safety and quality of life.

Airbnb provides several options for neighbors to report problems:

- For urgent disturbances, parties, or safety concerns, residents can contact Spring Valley Lake Public Safety Department (760-245-6400). Then immediately report to Airbnb's 24-hour Neighborhood Support Line through the support page and place a call for service.

- Residents should document incidents whenever possible by recording:

- Dates and times of disturbances

- Vehicle descriptions and license plates
- Photos or videos of violations
- Noise levels, parking problems, or overcrowding
- Any communication with hosts or guests

- If there is criminal activity, trespassing, threats, or unsafe behavior, residents should contact local law enforcement first before reporting to Public Safety and filing

Excessive disturbances, repeated nuisance activity, and irresponsible short-term rental practices place unnecessary strain on community resources and can negatively impact neighborhood stability. Consistent and accurate reporting by residents is essential to ensure that Spring Valley Lake remains a safe, respectful, and family-oriented community for all residents.

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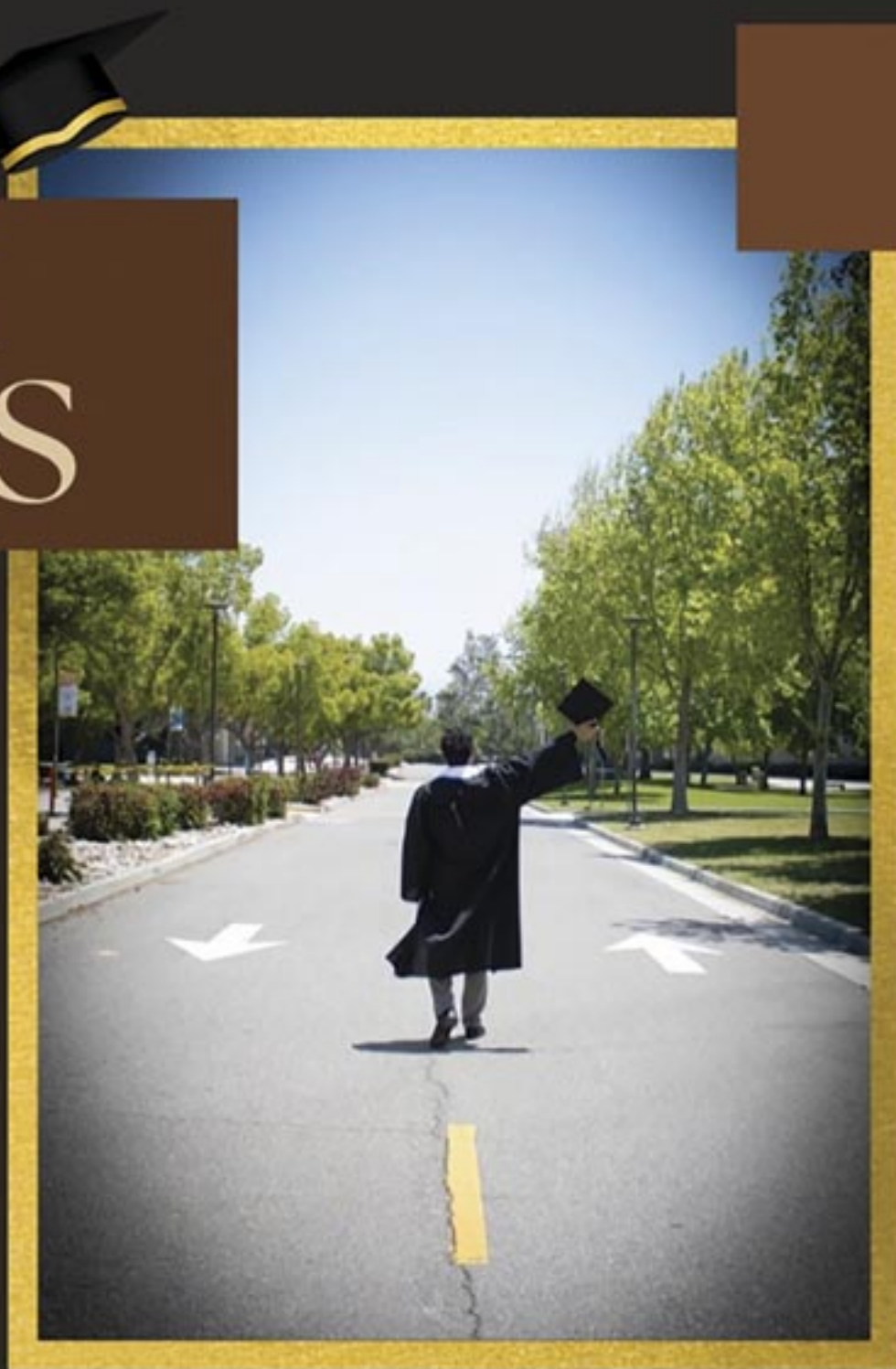

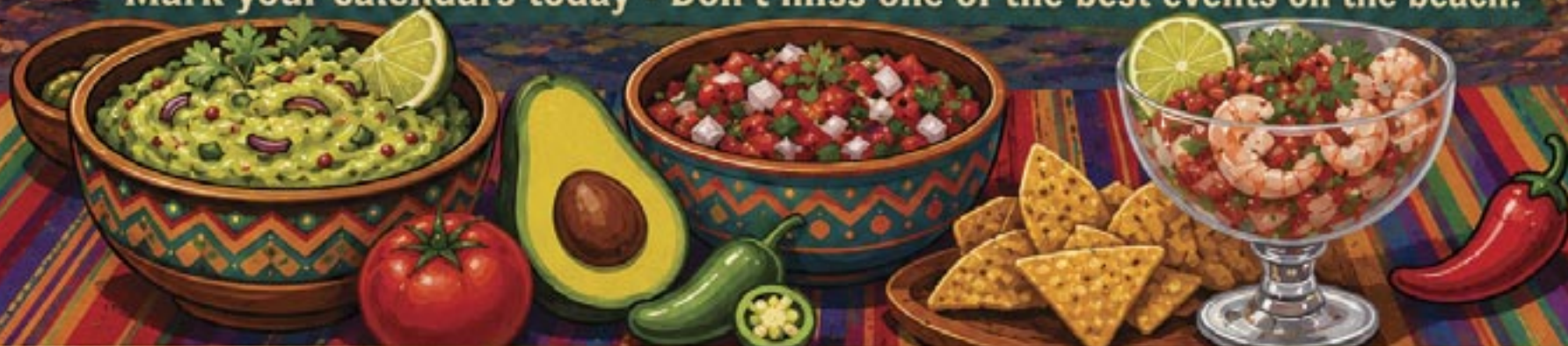

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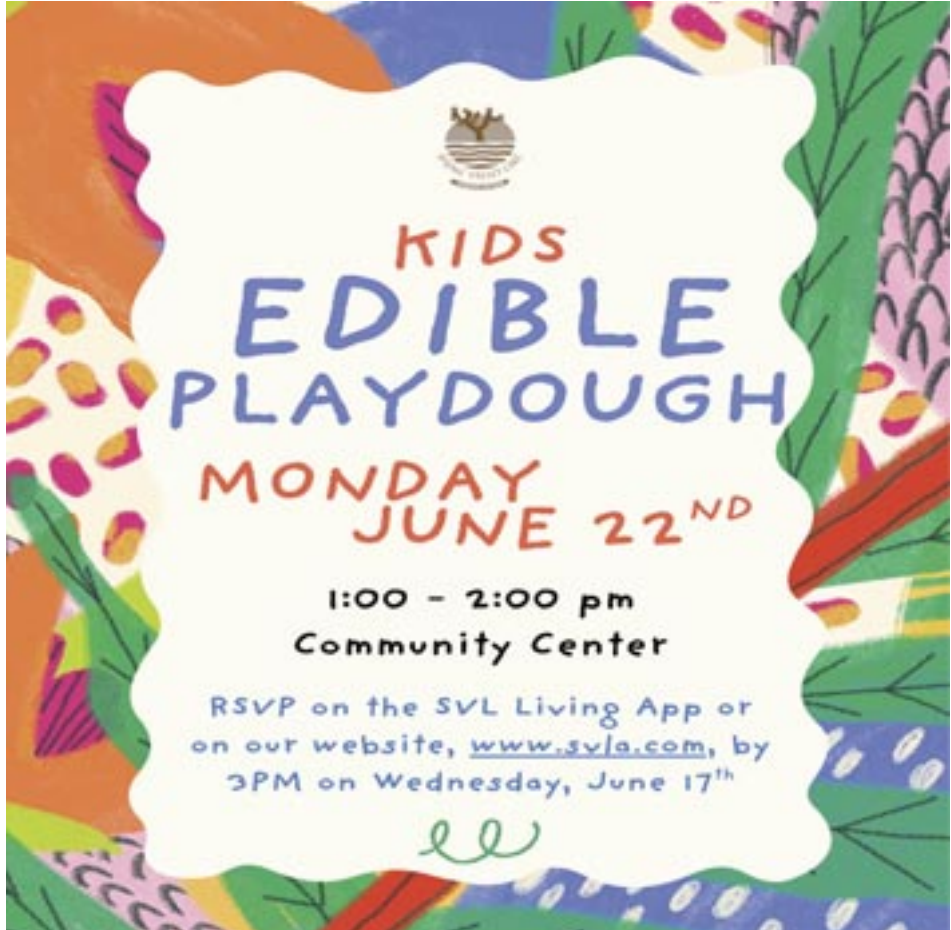
