**A Message from the Board of Directors Regarding the
Upcoming Lake Lowering Project:**

Dear Members,

As part of the Board's ongoing commitment to keeping the membership informed, we would like to provide an update on the Lake Lowering Project. The project remains in the evaluation and planning stages, and no final decisions have been made regarding the scope of repairs. The Board continues to work with members of the Lake Committee and Lake Task Force, along with qualified professionals including biologists, Solitude Lake Management, engineers, the Association's legal counsel, and other industry experts to evaluate the condition of the lake and identify the most appropriate long-term solutions.

The Association is also obtaining estimates from experienced contractors to evaluate potential repairs to the lake liner, shoreline cove areas, and other infrastructure that may require attention while the lake level is lowered. This information, together with expert recommendations, environmental requirements, engineering evaluations, legal guidance, and the Association's financial resources, will assist the Board in making informed decisions on behalf of the community.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as this important work continues. The Board remains committed to providing regular updates as additional information becomes available and key milestones are reached. Thank you for your continued support as we work to preserve the long-term health and sustainability of our lake for current and future generations.

As part of the Association's ongoing efforts to prepare for the upcoming lake lowering project, the Board of Directors has approved a temporary modification to the Association's fishing regulations.

Effective immediately and continuing until the lake lowering project begins, all daily catch limits have been suspended. Members and their guests are encouraged to catch and keep fish from the lake. This temporary change is intended to help reduce the fish population prior to lowering the lake and to minimize the number of fish that may be impacted during the project.

All other fishing regulations remain in effect, including the requirement to fish only in authorized areas and to conduct all fishing activities safely and responsibly. Any fish that are kept must be properly handled and disposed of.

Fish may not be discarded along the shoreline, beaches, parks, or other common areas.

The Board continues to work with Solitude Lake Management and other qualified professionals to evaluate additional fish management strategies as part of the lake lowering project. We appreciate your cooperation and support as we take proactive steps to protect the long-term health of Spring Valley Lake and complete this important community improvement project.
